GENTS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP



The Club Championship is a 4-round stroke play competition, with the Club Championship itself, the Milton Cup and the Milton Shield all to play for – see above trophies. The Club Championship is a scratch competition, and the handicap scores count for the Milton Cup and Milton Shield. The Championship will be held as follows:

Round 1 Sunday 9th June

Round 2 Saturday 15th June } tee times will be bookable from Friday 7th June at 21:00

Round 3 Sunday 16th June }

Round 4 Saturday 22nd June - no booking is required for this round as tee times will be seeded and advised via the booking system.

The first three rounds are open to members who have valid competition handicaps, and are played as 'Medal' rounds from BLACK tees, with winners for nett scores in each section, as normal. The fourth round is played in seeded order with leaders teeing off last. Full members who have returned scores in the first three rounds will qualify to play in the fourth round.

Rounds 2 and 3 of the Ladies Club Championship will be played alongside the Gents Championship on Saturday 15th June and the final round on Saturday 22nd June.

The winner of the Club Championship will be the best aggregate gross score over the four rounds. He will get his name on the Honour Board as Club Champion 2019, and on the Club Championship trophy and will receive a memento (or voucher) from the Club. The winner will also go through to the Evening Express Champion of Champions Scratch competition.

The Milton Cup and Shield will be awarded to the lowest aggregate nett score over 4 rounds – the Milton Cup for handicaps up to 12 and the Milton Shield for handicaps 13 to 28. Winners will get their names on the appropriate trophy and will receive a memento (or voucher) from the Club. The handicap held for the first round determines which trophy you play for.
